2. Chairperson's message

2.1 Shri Tilak Raj Dua, Chairman, warmly welcomed all participants to the AGM. He expressed his appreciation for IAFI's active involvement in domestic and international meetings, seminars, and events organized by the ITU, APT, DoT, BIF, WWRF, and other relevant organizations. He noted the association's significant contributions to the ITU and APT, as well as its proactive engagement in submitting comments on TRAI Consultation Papers and participating in TRAI's Open House Discussions. Furthermore, he acknowledged IAFI's ongoing efforts in providing feedback to the TEC and DoT and raising important issues through regular correspondence with the PMO, Hon'ble MoC, Hon'ble MoS, Secretary (DoT), DCC Members, Secretary (TRAI), and key officials. Shri Dua emphasized IAFI's remarkable global growth and its recognition as a key stakeholder in spectrum and ICT standardization. He commended Shri Bharat Bhatia, IAFI President, and his team for their exceptional financial achievements over the past five years. In closing, he highlighted the association's key events throughout the year and expressed his gratitude to all IAFI members for their ongoing support.

3. Annual Report of the work of the society during the financial year 2025-26

3.2 In his speech, Shri Bhatia shared a summary of the activities of the society during 2025-26 in the following areas:

- iii. Organise and manage Industry Events - Almost one event every month – In India and internationally
- iv. Responses to TRAI and DOT Consultations on Licensing frameworks, authorisations, spectrum, microwave, satellite policy, UCC, etc Press Releases on various topics every month.
- v. Revamped Weekly News sent every week to members

- vi. Over 100 Press articles in all Media channels
- vii. Hosted Joint events with global organisations .
- viii. Hosted three receptions in other countries to support India's candidate in ITU PP-26 around the world.
- ix. Revamped our website and moved the hosting server to a global cloud server for better and faster access from other countries
