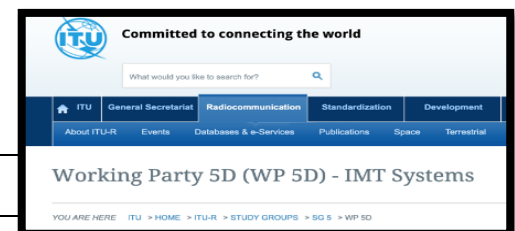

## THE WEEKLY NEWS SUMMARY

### Telecom Stories:

India is targeting the rollout of the 6G telecom network, which will provide ultra-high speed internet connectivity. India currently has 3G and 4G telecom networks and companies are gearing up to launch 5G over the next few months. Prime Minister Narendra Modi emphasised that “this is not about increasing speed but also the pace of development and creating jobs. Furthermore, he added that Tele density and internet users are fast expanding, adding that mobile manufacturing units in India have expanded from 2 to over 200 and the country is now the world’s biggest mobile manufacturing hub.

TRAI on the occasion of its silver anniversary organised an International Regulators Roundtable on “Collaborative Regulations using RegTech and Technology Platforms. The main aim of this International Regulators Roundtable was to cover the use of RegTech and Technology Platforms for the purpose of curbing spam and leveraging platforms for effective management of countermeasures actions against fraudulent activities. The participants discussed creating an echo system through RegTech and Technology Platforms for improving digital connectivity inside the buildings.

The Indian Computer Emergency Response Team issued a directive in April asking tech companies to report data breach within six hours of “noticing such incidents” and maintain IT and communications logs for six months. India’s junior IT minister Rajeev Chandrasekhar said there will be no changes despite the worries, India has tightened regulation of Big Tech firms in recent years, promoting pushback from the industry and in some cases even straining trade ties.
