In the year 2003 i.e. the 17 years ago, a small group of telecom professionals and experts with long experience in the Telecom sector created an institutional mechanism to enable participation of Indian telecommunication fraternity on a much wider scale in the activities of ITU and APT. Through various Committees comprising of experts, ITU-APT foundation has been very active and has taken several initiatives to contribute to the policy formulation, implementation, regulatory framework and other government plans on issues concerning the Telecom sector development, digital India, standardization, spectrum, regional harmonization and so on.

- 12. This year ITU-APT Foundation brings you the most talked about topics i.e. **5G, Wi-Fi 6 and also the Satellite Communication**.
- 13. **5G**, indeed, today, it is the most talked about technology as the world prepares to reap the benefit of 5G through its use cases. There are various fast mover countries such as China, USA, Japan and South Korea etc. **As per recent report, India is also about to start large scale trials for 5G technology and various use-cases** and then expected to be followed by 5G auctions and its rollouts.
- 14. Nations across the globe are struggling to counter the threat posed by the pandemic. The pandemic has also been affecting economic and financial conditions worldwide, with India being no exception. Sectors such as IT/ITeS, electronics, automobiles, entertainment, transport, tourism, and exports are in trouble due to disruption in the global supply chain and routine operations. During such crisis times, the **broadband connectivity through Wi-Fi has provided the much need support to move the economic engine of the country**.

- 15. Recent IP traffic measurements indicate that peak IP network traffic has stabilized at 25% to 30% above pre-COVID-19 pandemic levels. In India, internet traffic surged by as much as 40% during the national lockdown. With our growing reliance on Wi-Fi, we are going to need faster, stronger Wi-Fi networks, which is now commonly known as Wi-Fi 6. The good news is that it has already started rolling out in several parts of the world. Wi-Fi 6 offers the following advantages over existing standards. Further, as India also embarks upon the journey to 5G and other new technologies and applications such as IoT/M2M, AR/VR, Robotics etc, Wi-Fi 6 needs to be made available well in advance to supplement 5G.
- 16.Other important and relevant topic in our focus is the Satellite Communications, because of its various advantages over terrestrial communication networks as far as providing services in remote and far flung areas is concerned. In such areas, Broadband through Satellite plays a very critical role. We at ITU-APT foundation of India, are very committed to the progress and awareness of Satellite Communications in the country and opening of the same for private sector to bridge the digital divide for connecting the unconnected.
- 17. In order to match with the pace and paradigm technological shift it is important that the association also start deliberating on new age subject matter of concerns such as small cells, in-building solutions, data security, cyber security, edge computing data centres including the robust telecom infrastructure creation.
- 18. The truly appreciate the dedication and hard work done by the Executive Council and the committed secretariat at the foundation, who have played a key role in building a strong, world-class organization and their efforts in addressing the current situation under testing times is a source of inspiration.
- 19.1 would also like to take this opportunity to thank all members and functionaries for their support and cooperation without which the Foundation could not have had a successful 17 year run and carving for itself an important position in ICT sector professional bodies. **Co-Chairman Shri R.
